The Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) is a federal immigration regulation (8CFR 214.3) that requires the Bureau of Citizenship and Immigration Services (BCIS) formerly Immigration and Naturalization Services to collect information on an ongoing basis, from schools and exchange programs relating to nonimmigrant foreign student and exchange aliens during the course of their stay in the United States, using electronic reporting technology.

BMCC is required to submit specific immigration information concerning your nonimmigrant (F-1) status in the US. In order not to jeopardize your current nonimmigrant F-1 status, please answer accurately the questions below.
