## **Full-Time Scholarship Application**

### **General Information**

The BMCC Foundation Inc. scholarship is a general scholarship made available annually by the Board of Trustees of the BMCC Foundation Inc. to continuing BMCC students who demonstrate high academic performance and financial need. The scholarship amount varies and may cover up to \$2,800 per year. The Board of Trustees of the BMCC Foundation Inc. is comprised of business and civic leaders of the downtown Manhattan community. The Board has, as its mission, the following: to provide leadership and support to the College in the procurement of external resources needed for the College to meet its objectives and goals and to assist the College in strengthening and developing relationships with the various constituencies of the community in which the College resides and functions.

### **Instructions**

Submit a complete scholarship/award packet to the Scholarship Office, Room S343, no later than **April 2, 2009.**

### **How to Apply**

Please submit the following

- Application form, typed or printed
- A one page **typed** essay discussing your long-range academic and professional goals and your financial need
- Two letters of recommendation, at least one from a BMCC faculty or staff member on a BMCC letterhead and the other from any adult who knows you well. Both documents should contain official letterheads and signatures.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

- Must be a BMCC student who has completed at least one semester with a minimum of 12 real credits at BMCC
- Must demonstrate financial need
- Must have a minimum G.P.A. of 3.00
- Must maintain a minimum of 12 credits each semester with a minimum GPA of 3.0 after you receive the scholarship
- Must be enrolled in your first degree (please do not apply if you hold an Associate's, Bachelor's, Master's, or Doctorate degree)
- After receiving the scholarship, must volunteer or provide services for BMCC/Community events; in addition, must attend 3 MoneyWorks seminars of your choice
- Must register for 12 credits that are going towards your major every semester after receiving the scholarship
- Must complete all remediation by the end of the first semester the scholarship is received
