NEW YORK UNIVERSITY PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

NYU's B.S. Early Childhood/Early Childhood Special Education program requires 128-143 credits--52 credits of general education courses, 30 credits in a content core, and 61 credits of pedagogy courses. (See attached Program of Study Form.) The number of credits a student needs to graduate will vary from 128-143 depending upon their choice of content core. While BMCC students must complete 52 credits of general education courses, they will be held for one math and one science course rather than the two indicated on the Program of Study Form.

**TRANSFERRING CREDITS FROM THE BOROUGH OF MANHATTAN
COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

Students completing the A.A.S. in Child Care/Early Childhood Education (Infant Toddler or Pre-School Area of Study) at the Borough of Manhattan Community College may transfer 59 of their required 62 credits toward a B.S. in Early Childhood/Early Childhood Special Education. Please note that courses transferring to The Steinhardt School of Education must have a grade of "C" or better.




