Men Interested In Nursing

Nursing: The Nursing Department is located IN S785. You can contact the department by phone at (212) 220-8230. The chairperson of the Nursing Department is Barbara Tacinelli.

Men Interested In Accounting

Accounting: The Accounting Department is located in S623. You can contact the department by phone at (212) 220-8185. The chairperson of the Accounting Department is Lloyd Carroll. The Accounting Program is designed to provide the student with a strong preparation in accounting, business and liberal arts. The Accounting Program prepares students for entry-level positions in the accounting field.

Women Interested In Business Administration

Business Administration: The Business Management Department is located in S660. You can contact the department by phone at (212) 220-8205. The chairperson of the Business Management Department is Chaim Ginsberg. The Business Administration Program here at BMCC, administered by the Business Management Department, provides students with a general education background and 12 credits in basic business. After completion of the program, students may transfer to a senior college or university to attain the baccalaureate degree in business. The Business Administration program awards an Associate in Arts (A.A.) degree.

Women Interested In Business Management

Business Management: The Business Management Department is located in S660. You can contact the department by phone at (212) 220-8205. The chairperson of the Business Management Department is Chaim Ginsberg. After completion of the first semester of work, which includes basic courses in business and the liberal arts, students may prepare for employment or continue their study in a specific area of business management. This is typically considered a non-transferable degree, however many colleges have articulation agreements with BMCC where all of your credits will be accepted.

Women Interested In Small Business Entrepreneurship

Small Business Entrepreneurship: The Business Management Department is located in S660. You can contact the department by phone at (212) 220-8205. The chairperson of the Business Management Department is Chaim Ginsberg. The Small Business Entrepreneurship program is a two-year program leading to an Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree. This is typically considered a non-transferable degree, however many colleges have articulation agreements with BMCC where all your credits will be accepted.

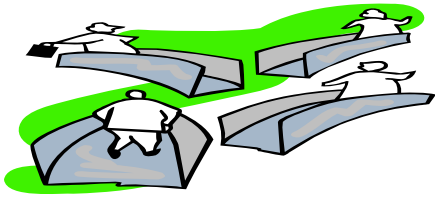
Association of Computer Machinery Club: (ACM)
