

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
UNIVERSIDAD DEL SAGRADO CORAZÓN
AND
BOROUGH OF MANHATTAN COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Universidad del Sagrado Corazón in San Juan, Puerto Rico, and the Borough of Manhattan Community College in New York share common interests: to further de access of minorities to higher education, and to increase the number of minority students obtaining degrees in all professional fields, including Nursing, Social Science, Science, Technology, Business and Communication degrees. Both institutions are located in urban settings, have strong ties to their communities, and provide services to large numbers of Hispanic students.

Under this articulation agreement, students who complete an Associate degree at BMCC and meet the established transfer requirements as outlined below will be accepted, with junior status, at USC to continue studies towards the credits required for the Bachelor's degree. To take advantage of this agreement, students must enter a Bachelor degree program that continues in the same discipline as their Associate degree. In other cases, USC commits itself to accept as many credits as possible consistent with the academic integrity of the fields.

PURPOSE

This agreement defines a structure through which articulation on all levels can be supported. This agreement is specifically designed to allow for maximum transfer of credits and a seamless transition for students earning an Associate degree at Borough of Manhattan Community College who want to complete a Baccalaureate degree at Universidad del Sagrado Corazón.

General Provisions

- 1.) USC and BMCC will cooperate in developing offerings and processes that will facilitate the transfer and validation of credits from BMCC to USC.

- 2.) This agreement will be reviewed annually by the BMCC Office of Academic Affairs and Academic Advisement and *Transfer Center* by the USC Office of Academic and Student Affairs and the *Registrar Office* to evaluate any changes in competencies, content, or standards. This may include exchange of visits between officials of both institutions.
- 3.) BMCC and USC agree to appoint a faculty member to serve as joint advisor and to assist students in preparing their academic programs. Such system will reassure students that they are following the prescribed program of studies agreed upon by both institutions.
- 4.) The terms of this Articulation Agreement shall be revised or renewed every three years, provided however, that it may be terminated by either party upon one year's written notice. However, such termination shall not affect students already enrolled.
- 5.) This agreement will be filed with BMCC Office of Academic Affairs, BMCC Office of Academic Advisement and *Transfer Center* and by the USC Office of Academic and Student Affairs and the *Registrar Office*.

Processes, Transfer of Credits, and Other Considerations

- 1.) During the first semester of each academic year when a BMCC student will graduate from an Associate degree, the student will send his/her application for transfer/admission, documented by an official transcript, to USC.
- 2.) Participating students must be fluent in both English and Spanish. Most courses at USC are offered in Spanish. For English dominant students, a Spanish language immersion experience will be designed prior to their academic year courses and, based on student needs, some of the courses may be taught in English.
- 3.) Applicants with GPA of 2.50 or better will be considered for transfer. Only courses with a grade of "C" or above will be accepted as transfer credit for

required courses in the major. Other courses approved with a "D" grade as part of the Associates degree program will be considered as transfer credit.

- 4.) BMCC students are eligible to receive financial aid, based upon financial need and/or academic merit as any USC student. Student must file the FAFSA by February 15th each year.
 - a.) Transfer student with a GPA of 3.50 or higher enrolled in 15 credits or more are eligible for an honor scholarship equivalent to \$30.00 per credit. Those enrolled in 12 credits are eligible for a scholarship of \$20.00 per credit.
 - b.) Other institutionally funded programs with different requirements or applicable to specific majors are described in our website.
- 5.) Students will be given priority for housing at the University residences when they meet the dateline for applying to such service. The fees will be those prevailing at the time of enrollment.
- 6.) Student can participate in all the Title IV Programs at USC assuming they are eligible subject to the availability of Campus Base Funds.
- 7.) Upon acceptance at USC, transfer students will be bound by the academic or other provisions applicable to the general student population.

PROGRAMS APPROVED FOR ARTICULATION

Appendix A lists the programs at the Borough of Manhattan Community College that will participate in this agreement. This list will be updated periodically following the procedures described in the following section. Credits transferred from these programs and credits remaining to be taken at Universidad del Sagrado Corazón are described in Appendix B and C respectively as part of this agreement.

REVIEW AND AMMENDMENTS TO AGREEMENT

- 1.) This agreement will be reviewed on an annual basis.

- 2.) Substantive changes in the courses or program requirements of either institution at any time will be discussed between the appropriate academic and administrative officers at Universidad del Sagrado Corazón and Borough of Manhattan Community College.
- 3.) At the request of either party, a review of the contents of this agreement will be conducted by the two institutions.
- 4.) This agreement may only be altered or amended by the written consent of both parties.

LONGEVITY OF AGREEMENT

This agreement will be in effect for three years from the date of administrative endorsement. Renewal of agreement with appropriate content changes will be discussed at the end of this time period. Transfer information will be updated on an annual basis.
