

The Brooklyn College Foundation Presidential Scholarship Program

The Brooklyn College Foundation Presidential Scholarship Program offers entering freshman students \$4,000 a year for up to four years of undergraduate study or until completion of the bachelor's degree. Scholarships are subject to financial availability. The College reserves the right to reduce or rescind scholarships if financial circumstances dictate.

Eligibility

Selection is based on merit, as measured by SAT scores and high school performance. In general, in order to be considered, a student will need to have a combined score of at least 1,200 in the critical reading and math sections of the SAT (or the equivalent on the ACT) and a 90 percent high school average. Readmitted students, with 6 credits or less, who have not attended another college may apply as entering freshmen. Community service and cocurricular activities will also be considered.

All candidates for the Brooklyn College Foundation Presidential Scholarship Program must be eligible for admission to Brooklyn College and must complete an application for undergraduate admission to the City University of New York (CUNY), indicating Brooklyn College as their first choice. Applications are available online and at New York City high schools, or they may be obtained from the Brooklyn College Office of Admissions.

New transfer students with a 3.40 grade point average or better and an associate degree, or at least 24 credits, will be considered for a scholarship for up to two years. Students with 23 credits or less must have a 3.40 grade point average and the required high school criteria.

Performance

In order to remain eligible, scholarship recipients must be pursuing a degree, maintain continuous full-time enrollment (12 credits or more), and have a minimum grade point average of 3.00.

To apply

Applicants must complete both the CUNY application and a scholarships application, with the following exception. Applicants who wish to be considered for



the CUNY Honors College, the B.A.-M.D. Program, the Brooklyn College Scholars Program, or the Engineering Honors Program must complete the appropriate application for each. Students who apply to these programs do not need to complete the entering freshman scholarship application. They automatically will be considered for all scholarships and award opportunities. Entering freshman applications must be received at the Office of Scholarships or postmarked by **January 14** for the following academic year. New transfer applications are due on **June 2**.

A limited number of entering freshman Presidential Scholarships may be deferred for up to one year. To be considered for a deferral, students must check off the appropriate box on the application.
