State Exam Pass Rates, Attrition/Retention, and Six Month Positive Placement Data, 2017-2019

Students considering the paramedic program major should review the following data. The paramedic major is an extremely demanding program requiring a solid grounding in the sciences, a significant time commitment, and the ability to complete didactic, psychomotor, affective, and clinical requirements in a fast-paced environment. The majority of those who successfully complete the program pass the state certifying exams; an average of slightly over half of graduates secure employment within six months and almost all are employed within EMS by the one year mark.
