- ¹ Developmental courses have 0 credits, however, their hours are counted towards full-time status and for financial aid purposes.
- ² CHE 118 is an alternate option. Students will need to take this course during a summer session in order to graduate within 2 years.
- ³ CHE 118/121 must be passed in order to take BIO 425.
- ⁴ Students are required to either take EMC 100 or get credit for life experience if certification has already been obtained.
- ⁵ BIO 425 must be passed in order to take BIO 426.
