- ¹ Developmental courses have 0 credits, however, their hours are counted towards full-time status and for financial aid purposes.

- ⁴ Students must pass MAT 150.5 in order to take CHE 121 and PHY 110.
- ⁵ CHE 121 must be passed in order to take CHE 122 and BIO 425.
- ⁶ A total of 15 credits is required. Some of these credits can be satisfied by taking STEM variants in the Common Core. Students are advised to select courses based on their desired career path.
- ⁷ A total of 7 credits is required. Choose 2 course from BIO 420, CHE 125, HED 235, SCI 150, SCI 151, SCI 510, or SCI 530. Students **cannot take both** HED 235 and SCI 150 to satisfy this requirement.
- ⁸ BIO 425 must be passed in order to take BIO 426.
