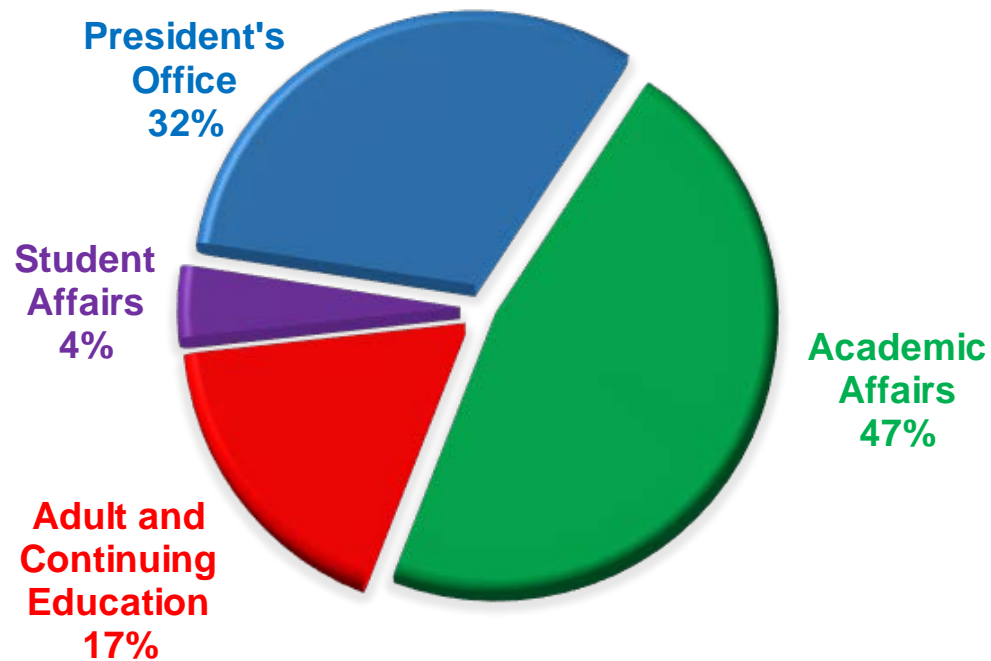

Distribution of Funding by Sector 2016 - 2017

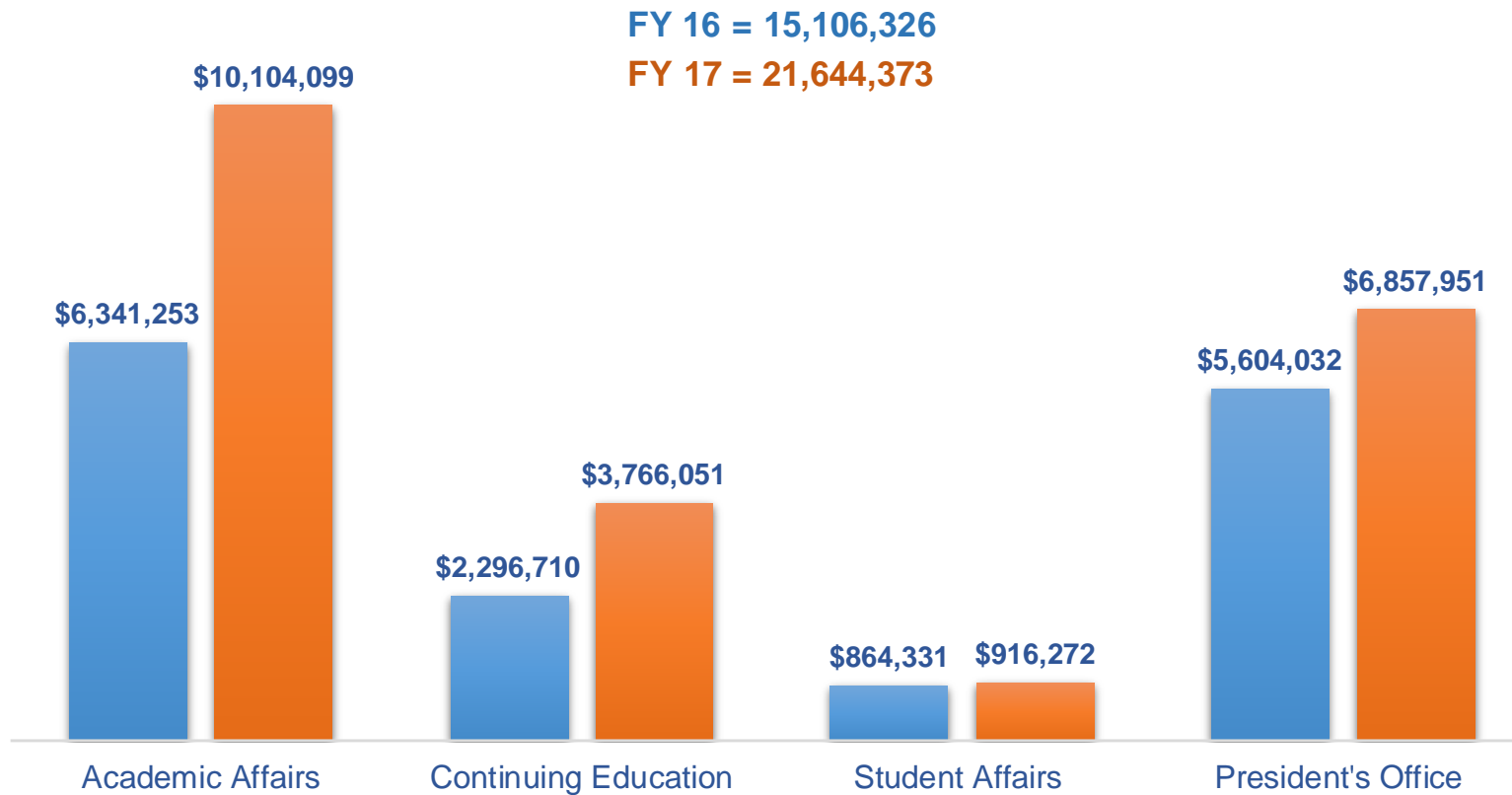

Two-Year Comparison of Awards by Division FY 2016 and AY 2017

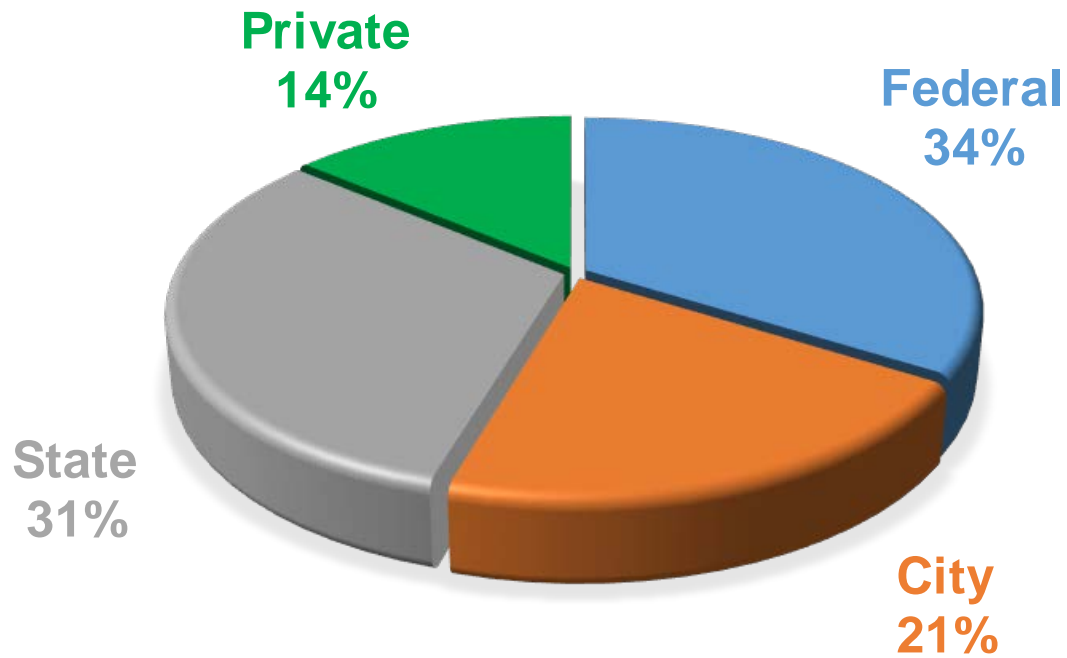

Two Year Comparison by Sector

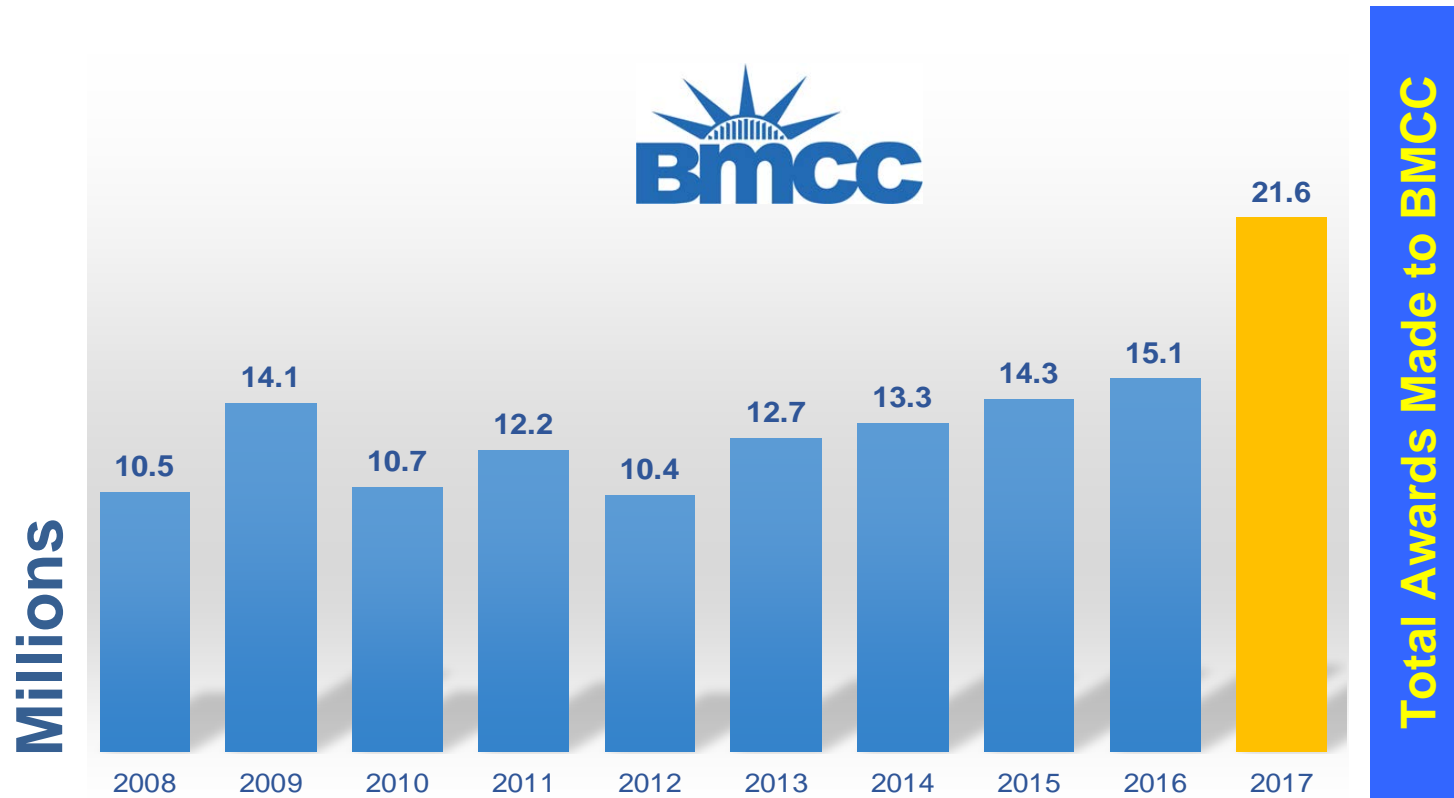


Distribution of Funding Sources for FY 2016-17

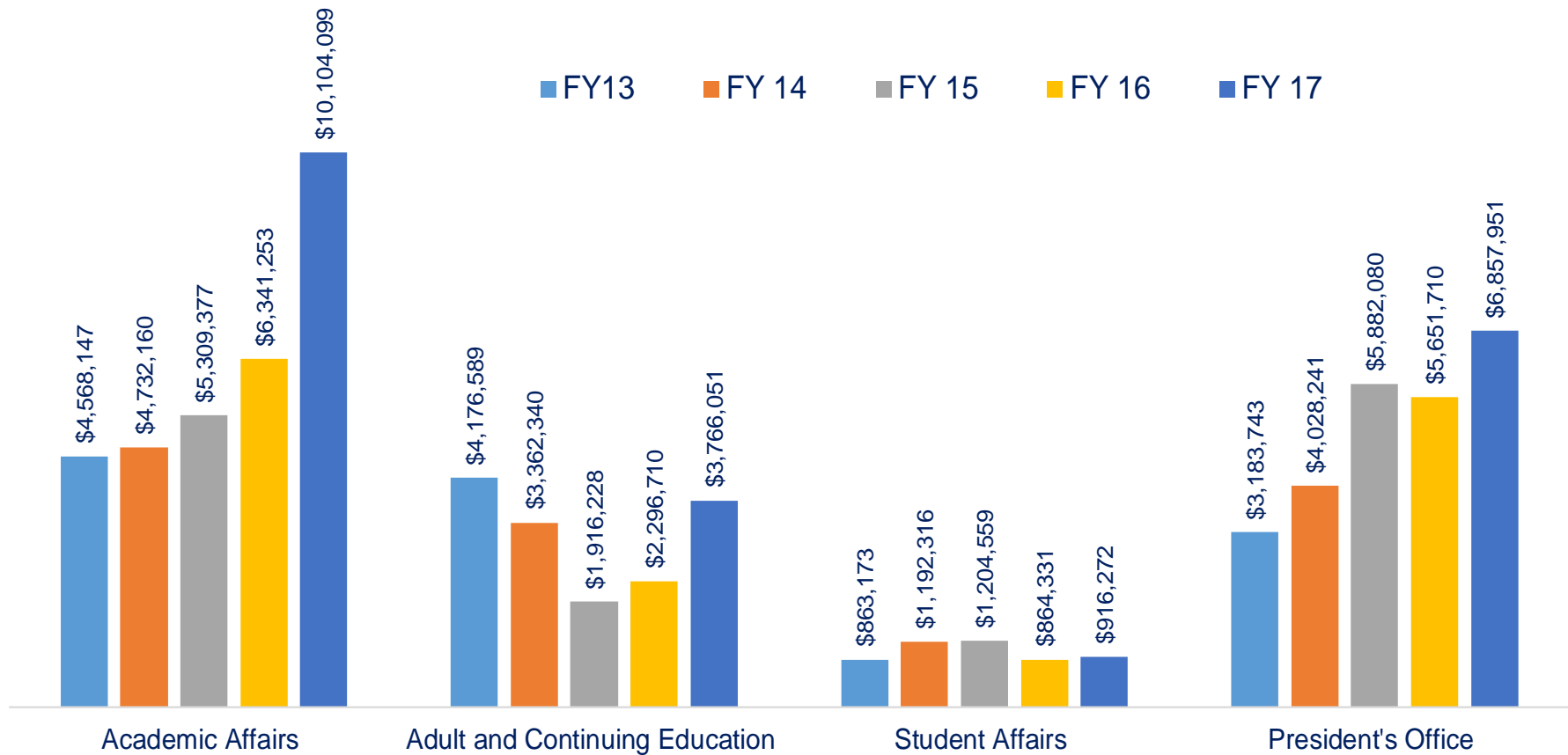

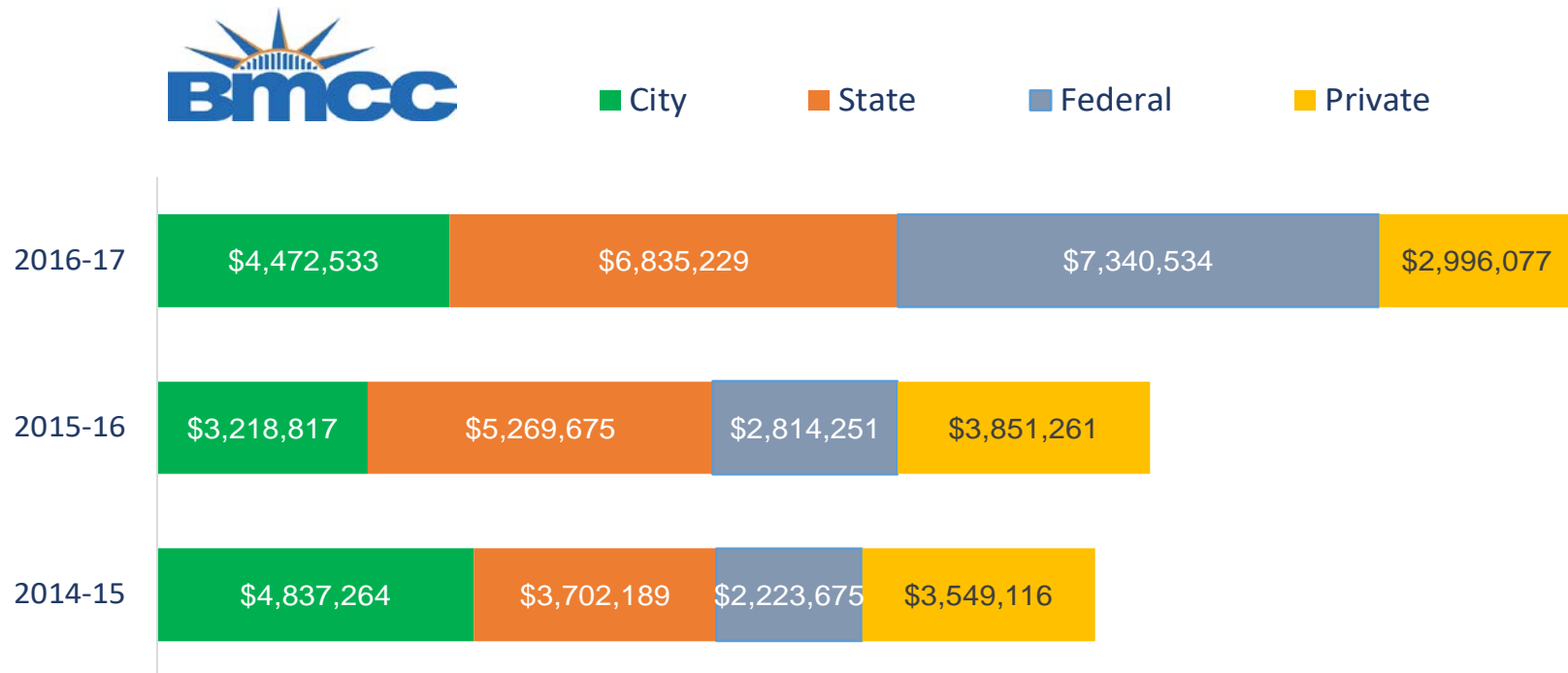
Ten Year Comparison of Awards Made to BMCC 2008 Through 2017
