Please note that MAT 104, MAT109 and MAT 216 <b>DO NOT MEET</b> the Liberal Arts Math requirement. In addition, Elementary Algebra (MAT012 or MAT051) is a pre-requisite for MAT 100, MAT125, MAT150 or MAT160. <b>MODERN LANGUAGES</b> (6 - 8cr., 3 -5 hr.). A one-year, two-semester sequence of the SAME foreign language is required. Students need to go to the Modern Languages Department (N540) for placement. <b>MUSIC/ART</b> (2 credits required) One semester of music or art is required. In music, either (2) two one-credit courses or (1) one two-credit course fulfills the requirement. <b>SCIENCE</b> - Two semesters of science are required, which may be (1) a one- year, two semester sequence in one of the following: BIO 210-220, CHE 201-202 or PHY 210-220 (4 cr., 6hr.) or (2) a combination of two of the following courses: AST 110, BIO 110, CHE 110 or PHY 110 (4cr., 5hr.). 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<p><b>SOCIAL SCIENCE</b> - Twelve credits required. Students must take social science courses in four different disciplines. They can satisfy this requirement by taking the following courses: ANT, ECO, GEO, HIS, PHI, POL, PSY, SOC, SSC, <b>HUM 101 ONLY</b>, LIN 100, CRT 100 or any social science course offered by the Center for Ethnic Studies. Social Science course from the Center of Ethnic must correspond to one of the four subject areas. For example <i>AFN 121 (History of African Civilization)</i> counts as a History course.
